**Pastor Harold & Dorthy Wilcox** continue to serve as interim pastor of the **Honolulu Kaimuki church**.

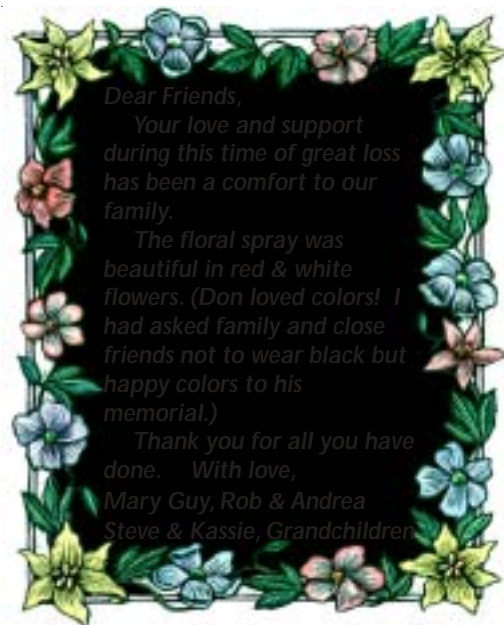

**HEALTH AND HOLINESS**

Health is a big concern for all of us. Americans spend \$1.7 trillion each year on doctor bills. As a matter of fact, General Motors pays more on health care than on steel. A large amount of what we spend is for the treatment of various symptoms. Unfortunately, many people continue with the treatment of symptoms rather than dealing with the root cause of the symptom. We mask the real cause with various medications.

There is a parallel in the spiritual area. God's desire is that each of us be spiritually healthy. Yet, many Christians seem content to deal with symptoms rather than dealing with the root cause of the problem. The Apostle Paul wrote to the Corinthian church about acting like infants when they should have been adults (1 Cor. 3:1-3). There was a root problem that the KJV describes as "carnal" or worldly. Even though we have recognized Jesus Christ as our savior, we have not allowed Him to be Lord! We find ourselves dealing with the symptoms by continuing to struggle with anger, bitterness, selfishness, etc. God desires that we live a life of holiness and allow the Holy Spirit to remove that "root cause" or the "carnal nature".

Allow me to again say, God desires for each of to be spiritually healthy, living holy lives in an unholy world. That is only possible when we have entered into a life of holiness. 1 Thess. 3:7 tells us, "For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life."

If our churches are to be healthy it will require you and me (who make up the church) to be healthy, spiritually - which means to be holy or Christ-like. Paul tells us in Eph. 5:25-27, "...Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy ...and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless." Holiness should be the desire and longing of each Christian as physical health should be the desire of each of us. May we strive to live holy, healthy lives through the power and cleansing work of the Holy Spirit.
